



## **C3 Metals Announces Closing of Fully Subscribed \$8,050,000 Private Placement Financing**

**TORONTO, ONTARIO – November 15, 2023 - C3 Metals Inc.** (TSXV: CCCM) (OTCQB: CUAUF) (“C3 Metals” or the “Company”) is pleased to announce that it has closed its previously announced non-brokered private placement (see press releases dated November 1, 2023 and November 6, 2023) through the issuance of 115,000,000 common shares (“**Common Shares**”) of the Company at a price of \$0.07 per Common Share for total gross proceeds of \$8,050,000 (the “**Offering**”).

Proceeds from the Offering will be used primarily for continued exploration programs in Jamaica in addition to exploration and property costs for the Jasperoide, Peru project, as well as for working capital and general corporate purposes. In connection with the Offering the Company paid certain eligible finders cash commissions in the aggregate of \$42,600 and an advisory fee of \$107,100.

All securities issued in connection with the Offering are subject to a hold period expiring on March 16, 2024 and the resale rules of applicable securities legislation. The Offering is subject to the final approval of the TSX Venture Exchange.

### **ABOUT C3 METALS INC.**

C3 Metals Inc. is a mineral exploration company focused on creating substantive value for its shareholders through the discovery and development of large copper and gold deposits. The Company is actively exploring in Jamaica where it has identified 16 porphyry and 40 epithermal prospects over a 30km strike extent across its 20,700 hectare exploration licences package. Mining is currently the second largest industry in Jamaica, and historical mining dates back to the colonial eras of the 1500s (Spanish) and 1800s (British). The Company also holds approximately 24,000 hectares located in the prolific high-grade Andahuaylas-Yauri Porphyry-Skarn belt of Southern Peru. Mineralization at Jasperoide is hosted in a similar geological setting to the nearby major mining operations at Las Bambas (MMG), Constancia (Hudbay) and Antapaccay (Glencore). At Jasperoide, the Company has identified over 15 skarn prospects and an outcropping porphyry system over two parallel 28km belts. The Company has published a maiden

resource estimate on the first of these skarn targets, which contained Measured & Indicated Resources of 52Mt at 0.5% copper and 0.2 g/t gold.
